



Another Day is the first single release by Dallas R&B artist Nick Turale' on the D Town record label. Record Producer and Manager, Randy Jones, had very specific ideas on how he wanted Nick's love ballad and first music video to look as the debut would play on BET, VH1 and The Box.

Director/Producer Christopher Bigbie created a concept that exceeded D Town's expectations. After writing a script and drafting storyboards that met with Randy's approval, the video went into production utilizing such locations as two mansions in north Dallas, the Travis Walk area and the famous landmark Reunion Tower. Local actors and models were cast as extras



including Kim Dawson model Sonja who portrayed the Dream Girl. All of the locations for Another Day were filmed in a 5600K environment on Kodak 7293 Tungsten based film without any color correction. This yielded a "blue hue" to the footage to emphasize the correlation between Nick's longing to find true love and cold bleak rainy days.



When Nick finally meets his dream girl in the final scene, the video gradually becomes warmer in tone via electronic color correction. The shift in color implies to the audience that Another Day has arrived for our hero. The color correction and film to video transfer was performed by the Film



Workers Club of Dallas, Texas. The success of Nick's first single made way for a record deal with Ultrax Records, Inc./Ichiban International Corporation distributing his first album titled Life, Love & Pain.
